VINTAGE

As the second consecutive drought year, 2013 saw very little rainfall. The consistently warm weather lead to earlier ripening than normal. As can be expected of a warm dry growing season, the wines will be very expressive and approachable.

VINIFICATION

This wine was fermented and aged in equal parts concrete tank, new French oak, and stainless steel for 9 months.

TASTING NOTES

Notes of melon and marzipan are complicated with aromas of ash and guava. A gorgeous savory palate reveals clove, apricot, herbs, and Piave cheese rind. A lengthy finish is made complete with a swath of fresh acidity. This is the first bottling of Fiano from John and Jody Ahner's Luna Matta Vineyard. Deeply rooted in Campania and Sicily Fiano creates wines that strike a wonderful balance between richness and freshness. It is also known for it's ability to cellar for more than a decade.
